Watching Bluebottles is a one-man theatre show based on the life of a village Hall-keeper. He is on the eve of his retirement and has been left to set up the hall for his own retirement party. He looks back over his life and the life of the hall. The piece will resonate with anyone who has ever had the good fortune to attend any village hall function. Although the story is fictional, the play is adapted to each individual venue and the hall itself becomes an integral part of the performance, conjuring up the illusion of a local story told locally.

This new tour is a remount of the production which first toured in March 2005 and will feature a brand-new sound design. The company is also proud to announce that Ron Emslie will return in the role of the Hall-keeper. Ron has toured with Right Lines in "Who Bares Wins", "Whisky Kisses" and "From These Parts". He also toured as Willy Loman with Perth Theatre's "Death of a Salesman" in 2011 and recently completed a West End run with Darren Day in the new musical "The Last Session".
